Come help Miami Township Local 3768 Firefighters Union along with the Milford Community Fire Department raise money to bring the "Toughest Two Minutes in Sports" to the Greater Cincinnati Tristate area.

The Firefighter Combat Challenge (FCC) is an event like none other. It is deemed the "Toughest Two Minutes in Sports". Hundreds of firefighters will come to the area to demonstrate their profession's rigors and the athleticism it takes to tame the FCC. Each firefighter performs a linked series of five tasks which includes climbing a 5-story tower, hoisting a 42lb. hose roll, chopping, dragging a hose and rescuing a life-sized, 175 lb. "victim" as they race against themselves, their opponent and the clock.

The FCC travels across the United States with approximately thirty stops on its way. It is supported by over 30 companies and organizations that make a market in providing fire service related equipment and services. In addition to those 30 companies and organizations, the host city is responsible for generating approximately one-third of the revenue needed to hold the event.

The fundraiser is being held to supplement the cost to bring this free, family-oriented event to the Miami Township/Milford area. The fundraiser will consist of a rib eating contest between the fire, police and service departments of Miami Township and the City of Milford. **Present this flyer and 10% of your dinner proceeds will go towards funding the Firefighter Combat Challenge.** Come enjoy the fun and support an event that is like no other.
